**New Basketball Uniforms:**

Coach V will be pricing new basketball uniforms for next year. We will need 100 of them in various sizes. Jennifer Parker and Ellen Plummer have agreed to help organize the issuing of uniforms to ensure they will all be returned. Next year's fee for basketball participation will be raised to \$40 and if any child fails to return the uniform, they will be charged \$100 replacement fee.

**Renovations to the Gymnasium:**

1. Rick reported on the cost of resurfacing the gym floor. Resurfacing will cost \$1.00 per square foot. Refinishing the floor will cost \$0.32 per square foot. The bid for repainting the cinder blocks and the doors in the gym is \$3,792 and to paint all the area above the cinder block is \$1,525. The total cost of all painting would be \$5,317. All bids will be supplied to the church and it is our hope, they will help to pay 30% of these costs.
2. Chris Robinson agreed to contact Tad Gates concerning the sprinklers leading to the water problem around the gym doors.

**Sports:**

1. The First Tee program was discussed. If we could contribute \$1,500 to the program any of our students would be eligible to compete in the program, but will still be required to pay the participation fee. Add to the next year's budget.
2. Call ULM to see if we can host a cross country track meet at their facility.
3. Coach V to call to check on having a beginning of the year basketball tournament.
